If after graduating you can't find a job in your field,
Nipissing invites you to return, tuition free, for another year!

The first initiative of its kind in an Ontario University

The Nipissing University Promise Program will support you through all aspects of the University journey. Newly admitted and transfer students with less than 30 transfer credits enrolled in the Promise Program will have an advisor to help navigate each step of your academic and co-curricular involvement at Nipissing — the transition into academic studies, life on campus as a Laker, and career development.

What is the NU Promise?

Nipissing invites you to return, tuition free, for up to 30 additional credits* if 6 months after completing your 4-year undergraduate degree program with a 70% GPA and all required elements of the program, you have not secured career-related employment.

Program Framework

- 4-year program;
- Completion of specific yearly requirements in order to move from year-to-year in the program;
- Attendance at all regular meetings with program advisor and program sessions;
- Completion of academic skill-based, social engagement, and holistic development opportunities within each year of the program;
- Final year includes more focus on career ready program initiatives like a résumé clinic and mock interviews.

You are eligible if you:

- Complete all 4 years of the program;
- Graduate with 70% GPA or above;
- Illustrate active pursuit of employment with a daily log of activities and document attempts at obtaining employment;
- Check in monthly after graduation to show steps taken to obtain employment.

* Limited enrolment courses and programs are not included in the Promise Program and students must have completed required prerequisites to enrol in tuition free courses.
